FHRC works within a broad Christian framework, reflects our Biblical standards, and at all times is pleasing to God and uncompromising of our Christian values.

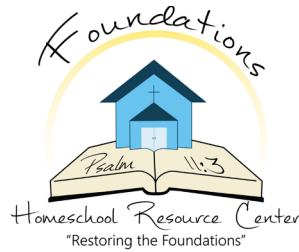
FHRC does all that we do to glorify Christ and shine His love to our community.

FHRC requires a signed Statement of Faith from all of our Directors, officers, employees, instructors, and educators.

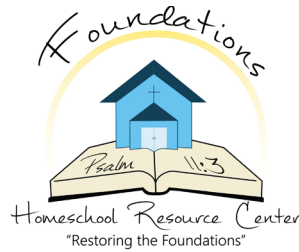

FHRC fervently believes that homeschooling is the most successful family-reviving and family-strengthening movement of our century.

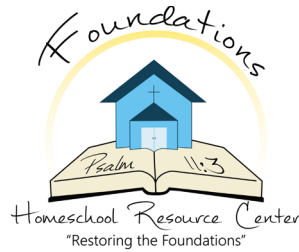

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God. We believe in the doctrine of Sola Scriptura. As a result, we shall follow an expository format except on rare occasions. (2 Tim. 3:16-17)
 2. We believe in the triune Godhead as eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (2 Cor. 13:14, Genesis 1:26).
 3. We believe in the deity of Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death, through His shed Blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His present ministry. (1 Tim. 3:16, Rom. 3:25-26)
 4. We believe in evangelistic and missionary fervor, and endeavor to obey the Great Commission to the best of our ability as individually called by Jesus. (Acts 1:8, Matt. 28:19-20)



5. We believe that for the salvation of the lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential. We further believe in the keeping power of God. (Heb. 9:22, Jude 1:24-25).
6. We believe in sanctification and holiness of heart and the overcoming life as God's design for the Church, which is the Bride of Christ. (Eph. 5:25-27)
7. We believe that marriage is the union of one man to one woman in covenant with God. Furthermore, we believe that marriage is a life-time commitment, and that every effort should be made to reconcile the husband and wife when disputes, conflict, or separation arise. (Matt. 19:3-6)
8. We believe in Christ's imminent personal return in power and great glory, and in his present and everlasting dominion and kingdom. (Acts 1:11, Rev. 1:7, Daniel 7:13-14)
9. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of eternal life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of eternal punishment. (John 5:27-29, Rev. 1:7, Dan. 7:13-14)
10. We believe that the ordinances of baptism by immersion in water and the observance of the Lord's Supper should be regularly practiced in the local assembly. (Matt. 28:19, Rom. 6:4, 1 Cor. 11:23-26)
11. We believe in the regular, weekly, in-person assembly of the believers. We believe that the State does not have any authority to dictate if and when we meet. (Heb. 10:25).
12. We believe that the Apostles in the Book of Acts is our model, and should be followed and emulated in every way possible in modern day.
13. We believe that sexual purity is a necessary expression for all of God's children and requires abstinence from adultery, fornication, incest, homosexuality, or other sexual relationships or practices forbidden by Scripture. We believe that like other sexual sins, homosexuality is a sin; the homosexual can be forgiven and redeemed through repentance and Confession of Faith in Jesus Christ. (Heb. 13:4, 1 Cor. 6:9-11, 1 Cor. 6:18, Lev. 18:1-30).



14. We believe that God created mankind as two distinct sexes: male and female and that each person affirms God's infinite wisdom by living in alignment with their birth sex. (Gen 1:26-28, Matt. 19:4-5)
15. We believe that since mankind is created in God's image, human life is of inestimable worth and significance in all its dimensions, from conception to the grave. As a result, we boldly support Life and oppose all forms of abortion and euthanasia for all reasons in all cases. Furthermore, we believe that Children are a blessing from God and blessed is the man and woman whose quiver is full. (Gen 1:27, Psalm 139:13-14, Psalm 127:3-5)
16. We believe that parents have an obligation to raise their children to be followers of Christ instructing them in the fear and admonition of the Lord. (Eph. 6:4) Furthermore, we believe that parents have a mandate to educate their children in the ways of the Lord and avoid secular education that opposes our faith and values. Furthermore, we believe that FHRC has a duty to help other Christian parents remove their children from public education and move to a Christian based educational system such as Christian homeschooling or a private Christian School. (Deut. 6:4-9)
17. We believe that the Church is for fellowship, instruction, and building up of the believers to share the Gospel in their spheres of influence and do the work of the Kingdom of Jesus Christ.
18. We believe that we are Christians defined as "followers of Jesus Christ" and are willing and able to make a public confession of their faith in Jesus Christ and his virgin birth, death, and resurrection. (Rom 1:16, Acts 11:26, Rom 10:9-11).
19. We believe that believers shall address any and all disputes or conflicts according to Biblical instruction. If disputes or conflicts arise that cannot be settled between or among the direct parties, FHRC shall bring the dispute or conflict to its Board of Directors, which can address the dispute or conflict following Biblical guidelines. All persons shall remember the grace and mercy shown to us, and remember that we are called to forgive our brothers and sisters 70 times 7. At no time shall any person seek judgment on a dispute or conflict, from any outside, secular court, judge, mediator, or arbitrator against another. (Matt. 18:15-17, 1 Cor. 6:1-8)
20. We believe that Founders, Leaders, Deacons and Elders shall recognize and seek to meet and maintain the qualifications of deacons and over-seers as outlined in Scripture in the Books of Titus and Timothy. (Titus 1:5-11, 1 Tim. 3:1-7, 1 Tim. 3:8-13)



21. We believe in a “young earth” and a literal interpretation of the Book of Genesis (please see #1 above). We believe that God created the Earth, the Sun, the Moon, the Stars, and all living creatures in six literal days and rested on the 7th day. We believe that God created Adam from the dust of the Earth, breathed life into him, and created Eve from Adam’s rib. As such, we believe that the Earth is approximately 6,500 years old rather than 4.5 billion years old. We do not believe in the “Big Bang, Evolution or other Scientific Theories that give credit to the formation of the Earth, the Universe, and living creatures by way of “Naturalism” rather than intentional Creation by God. We believe in a literal reading and interpretation of the story of Noah, and we believe that God destroyed the Earth and all of its creatures and occupants save those who were on the Ark.

22. We commit to the service of one another and humility, viewing other persons more highly than themselves. (John 3:30, Philippians 2:3-7).

This Statement of Faith does not exhaust the extent of our beliefs.

The Bible itself, as the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of mankind, is the sole and final source of that we believe.

For purposes of FHRC’s faith, doctrine, practice, policy, and discipline, FHRC’s Board of Directors has final interpretative authority on the Bible’s meaning and application to the entirety of FHRC.
